

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Organization

This competition is organized by Internet Architects B.V.B.A., (hereafter “the organizer”) which has its registered office in Koningin Astridplein 41, 2018 Antwerpen.

Validity

The contest is open for participation until February 10, 2012 at midnight. Any participation after this date and time will not be considered as a valid participation.

Contest Rules and Regulations

1. All persons older than 18 years and resident on Belgian territory may enter the contest, with the exception of personnel members of the organizer or the companies (including personnel members and employees) involved in organizing this contest. The participation is free.
2. By participating in the contest, the participants accept these rules and regulations unconditionally.
3. There can only be 1 entrant per email address.
4. There can only be 1 winner and one gift per email address.
5. There will be 5 winners in total.
6. Participants who answer the competition question correctly will qualify for the prizes. The 5 persons whose answer is closest to the [correct answer to the] tiebreaker question win the competition. If there is a tiebreak, the participant who sent in his/her entry first will win.
7. The gifts cannot be converted to cash, completely or partly and cannot be transferred to third parties.
8. The participant loses his/her right to the prize if that prize is not picked up during the collection period.
9. This contest is without any obligation to purchase.
